1. Applicants must be Canadian citizens by February 10th, 2005, and have written proof of citizenship; and,
2. Applicants must hold a Kukkiwon **DAN** Certificate, and a copy must be attached to the application; and
3. Applicants must be at least 15 years of age; and,
4. Applicants must pay the annual athlete registration fee to "Taekwondo Canada"; and
5. Applicants must obtain the approval signature of the affiliated Provincial/Territorial Taekwondo Association President in the Province/Territory in which he/she resides.

NOTE:

- Poom holders must have their Kukkiwon Certificate converted to DAN through Taekwondo Canada's National Office prior to the registration deadline. See the "Kukkiwon in Progress" form for details.

- * All supporting documentation must be postmarked on or before January 31st, or late charges will apply.
- * **Applications/Material RECEIVED after February 10th will be REJECTED** (no changes or additions will be accepted)
- * **An additional fee of \$25.00 will be charged for any changes (i.e. weight class change) requested to the "Identification Card" after the application form has been processed.**

Team Officials:

- Each province is permitted to register 1 of each of the following Team Officials: Team Manager, Team Coach, Team Trainer, and Team Doctor. Additional **coaches** (1st Dan WTF and up) are permitted to register. **All** team officials and individual coaches must submit an application form and adhere to the same registration deadlines. Coaches must wear proper attire (e.g. track suit – both pants and jacket, or business suits, shirt, and tie). Coaches are not permitted to wear shorts, jeans or T-shirts.

Referee Certification Course:

- Friday February 25th, 2005, from 08:30 – 16:00. This is an upgrade seminar. Please submit the "**Referee Certification Course Registration Form**"

Officiating Referees:

- Referee Chairperson will appoint each referee personally. For officiating referees, there will be a mandatory Referee Clinic on Friday February 25th, 2005, from 16:00 – 18:00 to review rules, etc. This is not an upgrade seminar. All officiating referees **MUST** attend.

Competition Format:

- Single Elimination and Repechage. Gold and Silver medallists from the 2004 Canadian National Taekwondo Championship will be seeded in positions 1 and 2 respectively on the tree, as long as they maintain the same weight category as in 2004.
- Gold and medallists will be determined as per single elimination format. Silver and bronze medallists will be determined using Repechage.

Match Duration:

- Elimination and Repechage matches: men and women: 3 rounds, 2 minutes, 1 minute rest between rounds.
- All women finals (Gold/silver/bronze): 3 rounds, 2 minutes, 1 minute rest between rounds.
- All men finals (Gold/silver/bronze): 3 rounds, 3 minutes, 1 minute rest between rounds.
- A sudden death round will take place for tied matches after three rounds

Weigh In:

- Two weigh-in attempts are allowed for each competitor, within the scheduled weigh-in time, to be conducted the day prior to the competition.

Equipment:

- WTF approved headgear and chest protector will be provided to each athlete at the tournament site. The athlete is responsible for: shin guards, groin protector, arm pads, mouth guard, etc. **According to WTF rules, the use of mouth guards is mandatory.**
- Each athlete, in each match, will wear the same size hogu.
- Athletes dobuks must represent their province only or be blank. Club, School and Canada markings must be covered.

Inspection:

- All competitors must pass the inspection desk before their match. Inspection sheets are used to confirm proper inspection.

Protest:

- A written report of the protested match must be prepared by the coach and submitted to the Arbitration Board within 10 minutes of the end of the match, with a protest fee of 300.00\$ in cash or money order.

Patterns:

- The patterns competition will be categorized by belt rank. Each category has its own required pattern. See competitor application form for details.

Access Restrictions:

- Access to the competitor area is restricted to (i) ring officials, (ii) the competing athlete, and (iii) 1 coach per competitor.

Doping Control:

- Doping Control testing may be conducted, in accordance with Canadian Policy on Doping in Sport and Canadian Doping Control Regulations (available online at www.cces.ca).

Poom to Dan Conversion Requirements:

- All athletes must be at least 15 years of age, and must have a Kukkiwon DAN Certificate. If you currently hold a POOM Certificate, you must apply for a Dan conversion through **Taekwondo Canada**. If you are applying for a Poom-to-Dan Conversion, or have recently applied for your Kukkiwon DAN Certificate, through Taekwondo Canada's National Office but have not received yet, you must submit the "Kukkiwon in Progress" form with your application package. **Organizing committee will communicate with WTF Canada for any "Kukkiwon in Progress".**
