



Solicitation

The Ontario Taekwondo Association (“OTA”) is seeking sponsorship for its high-performance Provincial Junior A and Senior Teams.

The Ontario Taekwondo Association is the Provincial Sports Organization representing WTF Taekwondo in Ontario. Its principle roles are:

1. To represent, advise and lobby with the Government and the public as the officially recognized Provincial Association of Taekwondo.
2. To promote interest and participation in the sport of Taekwondo;
3. To arrange tournaments and competition, and establish and grant prizes, awards and distinctions;
4. To establish and maintain grading standards for all levels for Taekwondo in Ontario ;
5. To enforce general rules and regulations for the sport of Taekwondo and to sanction tournaments in accordance with such rules and regulations;
6. To conduct annual Provincial Championships;
7. To select a Provincial Taekwondo team to represent Ontario at National events;
8. To receive money and other property, real, personal or mixed by gift, devise, bequest, fees or otherwise and to apply same as to the principal and income in furtherance of the foregoing.
9. To ensure the sport of Taekwondo as Safe, Accessible, Fair and Equitable participation **(S.A.F.E)**

Request for proposals

The OTA seeks bids from Canadian martial arts supplier to select one or more “Provincial Team Supplier(s)”, to be in effect for a period of One (1) years with the option to extend, on mutual agreement, for up to two further periods of one (1) year each (i.e. to a maximum of 7 years).

Specific support is sought as follows:

Provincial Team Supplier:

- 1) Annually provide suitably-sized and marked (provincial and Taekwondo official symbology) Track suits and uniforms for the members of the Senior and Junior Provincial teams.

An estimated 200 sets will be required each year. However, annual totals will differ based on team size and the number of competitions participated in.

Mandatory proposal content

Proposals must include photographs and detailed descriptions of the equipment, clothing, and goods to be provided under this sponsorship agreement.

Proposals must include:

- Evidence of prior successful sponsorships/testimonials (if available).
- A written acceptance by the bidder to comply with all applicable OTA policies and by-laws, particularly the Code of Conduct policy. All policies are available for public perusal on the website.

Evaluation

Proposals will be assessed on the grounds of best value to the OTA, as represented by value provided to the athletes. The primary selection criteria will be the quality and functionality of the equipment, clothing and/or goods.

Additional factors to be considered (in the case where more than one supplier offers excellent equipment) will include:

- Documented evidence of earlier success
- Evidence of a successful company track record, and expectation of continued service during the period of the sponsorship agreement.

Sponsor's rights

The "Provincial Team Supplier" will be officially recognized (your logo and company name) on:

- on the OTA's website;
- on all OTA correspondence and publications
- during OTA provincial competitions (your banner displayed and your status announced)
- VIP status at provincial events;
- your company name on all Uniforms and Track suits.

The "Provincial Team Supplier" will also have exclusive rights to sell equipment/accoutrements at all WTF-approved Provincial Selection Tournaments or events.
