To: Members of the Ontario Taekwondo Association (OTA)

The OTA Bylaw Number 7, section 2.06, states that *“Any member must be a Canadian Citizen or Landed Immigrant and permanent resident for at least six (6) months.”*

To my knowledge, it has not been the practice of the OTA to ask for confirmation of this with the membership applications in the past. Although we do believe the current members meet this requirement and although it has not historically been a requirement, at this point, we are required now to obtain such confirmation of qualification.

Accordingly, members will be required to provide proof that they have been a Canadian Citizen or Landed Immigrant and permanent resident of Canada for at least 6 months, by completing the enclosed “Certificate of Residency and Citizenship” form (this form is also available online at [www.taekwondo.on.ca](http://www.taekwondo.on.ca)).

The signed “Certificate of Residency and Citizenship” form must be **received by** the OTA Secretary General at the address below by mail, by hand, by email\*, or by facsimile **on or before Wednesday, October 17, 2007**.
