D) GENERAL INFORMATION:

SATURDAY, May 7, 2005.

WEIGH IN Multiple attempts are allowed for each competitor, within the scheduled weigh-in time, to be conducted the day prior.

Check Weight: Cobourg Memorial Arena 4pm to 5pm
Official Weigh In: Cobourg Memorial Arena 5pm to 6pm
Draw: Cobourg Memorial Arena 6pm to 7pm

SUNDAY, May 8, 2005.

Eliminations: 10:00a.m.

Match Duration: Eliminations: 3 rounds, 2 minutes each round, 45 seconds break between rounds.
Finals: 3 rounds, 2 minutes each round, 45 seconds break between rounds.

Officials: Each representing club will have coach passes available at Admission.

Referees: Ontario Taekwondo Association (OTA) Referee Chairperson will appoint referees for all qualifying tournaments.

Equipment: WTF approved equipment only. All competitors **MUST** provide their own protective equipment: **head gear, NEW chest protector, arm & shin guards, groin cup and mouth guard.**

Inspection: All competitors must pass the inspection desk before their match. Inspection sheets will be used to confirm proper inspection.

Protest: A written report of the protested match must be prepared by the coach and submitted to the Arbitration Board within 10 minutes of the end of the match, with protest fee of \$200.00 in cash or money order.

E) TOURNAMENT RULES

Format of Competition:

The purpose of this new format of competition is to encourage games participation for Ontario Junior Athletes to compete regular provincial competitions.

- Two games are scheduled for 2005 Ontario Junior Black Belt Team Selection, January 23, 2005 in Kitchener and May 8, 2005 in Cobourg.
- Single Elimination
- Points will be awarded to 1st place, 2nd place and 3rd places
1st place 20 points, 2nd place 15 points and 3rd place 5 points
- A ranking order is established with total points earned for junior athletes that participate in both Game 1 and Game 2-2005 Ontario Junior Black Belt Team Selection, which determines the 1st place, 2nd place and two 3rd places. The athlete accumulated the highest points after Game 2, will be the champion.
- Points will only be accumulated for those who participate in both games. Points will be transferable if moving divisions.
- There is a one game requirement for those who would like to participate at 2005 Canadian Junior National Taekwondo Championship in July 2 & 3, 2005.
- Top four ranked players at completion of Game 2 will be the supported Ontario Junior Black Belt Team, where they will receive a team outfit and some financial support- TEAM A only. Team B & C will only receive team outfit if they participate at 2005 Canadian National in Edmonton.
- In 2005, Ontario Team will be using the same team outfit as 2004, athletes that were 2004 Ontario Team will NOT be receiving a new team outfit.

TIE BREAKER

Two Way Tie: The following criterias will be used

1. Total points earned, on matches between the two players
2. Total points against, on matches between the two players
3. Least number deductions, warning is not accountable

Registration:

- Registration Fee and Membership Fee must be paid in full by deadline as stated on page 3, payable to OTA
- Late fee will apply, if registration is received after specified deadline date and must be paid in full prior to Official Weigh In, including late entries.
- There will be a \$20.00 service charge to any NSF cheques
- Registered competitor-in order to receive a full refund, a Doctor's Note must be presented to the Secretary prior to Official Weigh In. If Doctor's Note is presented after Official Weigh In, only half of the fee will be refunded

E) TOURNAMENT RULES-cont'd

UWeigh In:

- Weigh in will take place at location specified in Information Package-Page 4
- Weigh in will be held the day prior to Game 2, Check Weight will be available prior to Official Weigh In.
- All registrants must weigh in within the designated weigh in time, or will be disqualified
- Weigh in will be conducted by OTA designated officials
- Only appropriate gender officials will be conducting Weigh In.
- Each competitor will have multiple attempts of making weight, within the designated time
- If competitor does not make weight in the initial attempt, he/she and coach will be informed of how much he/she is over/under by
- If competitor(s) fail to make weight during the Official Weigh In time, he/she will automatically be disqualified, **THERE WILL BE NO REFUND**
