Dear Masters and Instructors:

Elite Martial Art Centre is proud to be hosting their sixth "E-MAC CHALLENGE" tournament on February 23rd, 2008 at the Port Hope High School in Port Hope, Ontario, in connection with the 2nd JR Selection the following day. This is an O.T.A. sanctioned tournament. WTF rules will apply to the black belt competition between the ages of 14 to 29. O.T.A. colour belt rules will apply to all other divisions. Please note that all competitors must be current 2007-2008 members of the Ontario Taekwondo Association. OTA membership will be checked upon registration. Application forms are available to download on the OTA website.

Enclosed is a tournament package including entry forms. Please make copies as necessary. **You will also note that this is a PRE-REGISTERED tournament only for both athletes and coaches with a deadline of February 10th, 2008 post mark. Coaches will be required to pre-register with their teams. If an athlete is not pre-registered, there will be a \$100 competition fee at the door. If a Coach is not pre-registered, there will be a \$50.00 fee for a Coach's pass charged at the door.**

In our quest to continue to provide the best possible and cutting edge competition for all in Ontario, we will be putting into place a unique program of events. We will be running four mini-tournaments within one. Since the competition is being held in a high school, the gymnasiums are smaller than we are accustomed to, therefore we will be utilizing both gyms and holding an "AGE NINE (9) & UNDER COLOUR BELT" tournament until completion, an "AGE TEN (10) TO THIRTEEN (13) COLOUR BELT" tournament until completion, an "AGE 14 & OVER COLOUR BELT" tournament until completion; and a "BLACK BELT" tournament. The goal is that athletes and their families can arrive at different times throughout the day; thereby reducing the number of people and congestion in the gyms at any one time. Patterns will be head to head single elimination format. There will be two larger rings with electronic scoring. The blue and red belt divisions will spar on those rings, with three (or four) judges (depending upon availability). All athletes will weigh in at the time of check in. Please adhere to the weigh in time, or the athlete risks not being able to compete in the sparring competition. Refunds will not be given if an athlete misses their division.
