



2009 Ontario Black Belt Team – Junior Final Ranking Game

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To all O.T.A. members:

This is to inform all members that the 2009 Ontario Junior Black Belt Team Final Ranking Game will be held on Sunday, April 19, 2009 at Cobourg Memorial Arena. Please note that this is for Junior A division only.

Please note:

- There will be a maximum of 4 Competitors per division in the Final Ranking Game.
- Athletes MUST have competed in 2 Provincial Qualifying Games to be eligible for Final Ranking.
- Athletes MUST compete in the weight division in which they are ranked.
- Athletes with a 1st place finish in any of the 3 Qualifying Games are automatically eligible for the Final Ranking (as long as they competed in at least 2 Qualifying Games).
- If any of the first 4 Athletes in the eligibility list decline to compete, other Athletes who have competed in 2 Qualifying Games will be considered in the order of points.

Please be advised that in order to compete at any of the O.T.A. provincial games, you must be a current (2009/2010) O.T.A. Black Belt Member. The School / Club must also be a member of the O.T.A.

It is imperative that you read and pay close attention to the rules and regulations stated under the sections for, Competitor and Coach. In order for the provincial tournaments to run more efficiently and professionally, it is very important that we all work together.

Registration Deadlines and Fees: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

Top 4 in each division:

- Registration Deadline for **applications AND full payment** must be RECEIVED, NOT post-marked by Friday, April 3rd, 2009.
- Registration fee as well as the OTA membership fee must be paid in full by the deadline. All cheques are made payable to "Ontario Taekwondo Association".

Other athletes in division:

- Registration Deadline for **applications AND full payment** must be RECEIVED, NOT post-marked by Friday, April 3rd, 2009.
- These athletes will be taken into consideration for competition for spots not confirmed by the top 4. If all top 4 are registered and paid, then return of application and payment will be made by the OTA.
- Registration fee as well as the OTA membership fee must be paid in full by the deadline. All cheques are made payable to "Ontario Taekwondo Association".

All Athletes:

- Final competitor list will be issued to clubs by **Monday, April 6, 2009.**

COMPETITON FEES

- Sparring only: \$73.50 (\$70+GST)
- **There will be a \$50 service charge to all NSF Cheques**

In order to receive a full refund, a Doctor's note must be presented to the Secretary General prior to Official Weigh-In.

COACH INFORMATION

All coaches must register and submit proof of Kukkiwon Dan Certificate. If your certificate does not have a photograph, you will be required to produce a photo I.D. at admission on the day of the tournament. Since we have most Black belt documentation on file, feel free to check with the Secretary-General via email to make sure your documents are on file for it is not necessary to keep sending it in. All coaches must be pre-registered. Coaches must be a current (2009/2010) OTA Black Belt Member in good standing.

Coaches must abide by Dress Code (suggested attire: athletic attire/team tracksuit or casual/formal attire must be accompanied by footwear acceptable once on competition area such as non-marking sole athletic/taekwondo shoes). NO dobuk (may be covered by a team jacket if coach is also a competitor), jeans, shorts, urban outerwear, dress shoes, sandals/slippers, gum chewing, use of electronics such as cell phones, PDA's, video, cameras are all unacceptable at coaches designated area.

COMPETITOR INFORMATION

It is the responsibility of all competitors to e-mail the secretary-general to check and make sure that this application and fee has been received. It is also the responsibility of all competitors to fill out the registration form accurately, submit all documentation and have all the appropriate signatures. Please note that if you have submitted a copy of your Kukkiwon certificate and proof of age, you no longer are required to do so, for it is now on file.

A competitors list will be posted to ensure all competitors are on the list accurately. There will also be a list of all registered coaches. Any errors or omissions must be immediately confronted to the Secretary-General.

Medal Presentation:

All competitors must be wearing full dobuk/uniform in order to participate in the medal presentation ceremonies.

COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicant must be a Canadian citizen residing in the Province of Ontario for a minimum of 6 months. A copy of the applicants Canadian Birth Certificate / Citizenship/ Passport must be submitted with the registration, if not already on file.
2. Applicant must be a Kukkiwon Poom/Dan Certificate holder. If the Kukkiwon application is applied through WTF Taekwondo Canada before the registration deadline, it will be accepted. Kukkiwon proof of the application from WTF Canada must be presented at the time of registration.
3. Applicant must be a current (2009/2010) OTA Black Belt Member in good standing. Also, the Club where the applicant trains Taekwondo, must also be a member in good standing.

WEIGH-IN

Multiple attempts are allowed for each competitor within the scheduled weigh-in time to be conducted on **Saturday, April 18, 2009**. Weigh-in will be conducted by OTA designated officials.

Pre Weigh-In:	3:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m.	Jack Heenan Memorial Arena
Official Weigh-In:	4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.	Jack Heenan Memorial Arena

Pre Weigh-In:

Pre weigh-in is strictly for a competitor to check if they are within their registered weight category. Under any circumstances, a competitor **will not be permitted to change** the weight category from that in which they are ranked.

Official Weigh-In:

During the official weigh-in, **there will be absolutely no change of weight category**. If the competitor does not make weight category, the competitor will be disqualified and the competitor will not be allowed to compete. There will be no refund.

COMPETITION

Sunday, April 19, 2009

Round Robin: Sparring Competition: 9:30 a.m.

Match Duration: 3 rounds, 2 minutes each round, 1 minute rest

- A sudden death round will take place for tied matches after three rounds.
- In the case where there are only 2 competitors in the division, the format will be best 2 of 3 matches.
- In the case of a 2 way tie, the winner of the tied athletes will be declared the winner.
- In the case of a 3 way tie, greatest total point spread will be used, if still tied, then greatest total points scored and if still tied, then least total points against.

Referees: Ontario Taekwondo Association (OTA) Referee Chairperson will appoint referees.

Equipment: WTF approved equipment only. All competitors must provide their own protective equipment: head gear, new chest protector, arm & shin guards, groin protector, gloves and mouth guard (clear or black colour). Sport glasses or goggles will not be permitted. Contact lenses are the only recommended eyewear. Please refer to the last page of this package entitled "size of trunk protector according to weight category" in order for all competitors to wear appropriate chest protector size.

There will be no equipment sold at the tournament.

Inspection: All competitors must pass the inspection desk before their match. Inspection sheets will be used to confirm proper inspection.

Medical: O.T.A. Medical Support Team will be on site to treat injuries and provide taping service - \$5.00/taping.

Protest: A written report of the protested match must be prepared by the coach and submitted to the Arbitration Board within 10 minutes of the end of the match, with protest fee of \$200.00 in cash or money order.

TOURNAMENT RULES

Competition Rules:

The new WTF Competition Rules will be applied with the exception of video replay [Rule Amendment Summary](#) (Note: Although this summary says Sr. Nationals, they will also be applied for Jr.).

Medal Presentation:

All competitors must be wearing full dobuk/uniform in order to participate in the medal presentation ceremonies.

BLACK BELT MEMBERSHIP

All participants and coaches at OTA Games must be current members of the Ontario Taekwondo Association "OTA".

Current membership will be expiring March 31, 2009.

If your Black Belt participant or coach is not an OTA member, please fill out the BLACK BELT MEMBERSHIP FORM (available at www.taekwondo.on.ca, under the section "memberships"); submit the \$20.00 membership fee (cheque or money order payable to OTA) along with the Competition Registration Form.

Please ensure a copy of Kukkiwon Certificate along with a copy of Birth Certificate/Passport/Citizenship is attached to the membership application for proper approval.

COACH REGISTRATION

Please note that all coaches who have already paid the fee of \$31.50 since September, 2008 do not have to pay again. This fee is valid until the final ranking game. However, this form must be filled out and submitted.
