To OTA Members:

This is to inform you of the 2005 Ontario Black Belt Team - Qualifying Games 2 will be held on **Sunday, December 5th, 2004 at Keswick High School, 100 Biscayne Blvd, Keswick, Ontario, as part of a two day event**, day 1 is Jung Ko Taekwondo Tournament on Saturday, December 4th, 2004. **Please note, although this is a two day event, there are two separate venues for day 1 and day 2, this is due to some unforeseen circumstances. Please read the Information Package carefully, with important information on venue and weigh in sites.**

The 2005 Canadian National Taekwondo Championship has been confirmed by Taekwondo Canada for February 26th and 27th, 2005, in Vancouver, B.C.. Please see the Provincial Point System Tournament Procedures posted on O.T.A. Web site, www.taekwondo.on.ca to reflect the two games selection process.

The Registration Fee for 2004/2005 Season has been revised to \$60.00 for one game(Game 2 only). For athletes that competed in Game 1 and had registered for both games, you are not required to re-register. Unless, there is a Weight Category Change, please email or fax change to the Secretary. If you only registered for one game (in game 1), paid \$60.00 for one game and wish to compete in Game 2, your fee will be \$60.00 (for game 2. If you competed in the 2003/2004 Ontario games, you are not required to resubmit the required documents: Kukkiwon certificate and/or canadian citizenship/passport/birth certificate.

Please be advised that in order to compete at any of the OTA provincial qualifying tournaments, you must be a current (2004/2005) OTA Black Belt Member. ELIMINATIONS:

**Game 2: Sunday, December 5th, 2004.
10 a.m. at KESWICK HIGH SCHOOL**

- Match Duration:** Eliminations: 3 rounds, 2 minutes each round, 45 seconds break between rounds.
Finals: 3 rounds, 3 minutes each round, 1 minute break between rounds-Male, 3 rounds, 2 minutes each round, 45 seconds break between rounds-Female
- Officials:** Each representing club will have two coach passes available on competition day.
- Referees:** Ontario Taekwondo Association (OTA) Referee Chairperson will appoint referees for all qualifying tournaments.
- Equipment:** WTF approved equipment only. All competitors must provide their own protective equipment: **head gear, chest protector(newly approved), arm & shin guards, groin cup and mouth guard.**
- Inspection:** All competitors must pass the inspection desk before their match. Inspection sheets will be used to confirm proper inspection.
- Protest:** A written report of the protested match must be prepared by the coach and submitted to the Arbitration Board within 10 minutes of the end of the match, with protest fee of \$200.00 in cash or money order.

QUALIFYING TOURNAMENT RULES

Format of Competition:

Please refer to Provincial Point System Tournament Procedures

Registration:

- Registration Fee and Membership Fee must be paid in full by final deadline, payable to OTA
- Late fee will apply, if registration is received after specified deadline date and must be paid in full prior to final deadline
- Whether you register in Game 1 or 2 or both, the registration fee-\$60.00 for one game or \$100.00 for both
- Day of Weigh In Registration, late fee of \$50.00 and must be delivered to OTA OTA Secretary during Pre-Weigh In session
- There will be a \$20.00 service charge to any NSF cheques
- Registered competitor-in order to receive a full refund a Doctor's Note must be presented to the OTA Secretary prior to Weigh In. If Doctor's Note is presented after weigh in, only half of the fee will be refunded

Weigh In:

- Weigh in will take place at the specified location on Information Package (pg.5)
- Weigh in will be held the day prior, Pre-Weigh In (check weight) will be available prior to Official Weigh In.
- All registrants must weigh in within the designated weigh in time, or will be disqualified
- Weigh in will be conducted by OTA designated officials
- Only appropriate gender officials will be performing Weigh In.
- Each competitor will have multiple attempts of making weight, within the designated time
- If competitor does not make weight in the initial attempt, he/she and coach will be informed of how much he/she is over/under by
- If competitor(s) fail to make weight within the designated Weigh In time, he/she will automatically be disqualified, **THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF REGISTRATION FEE**
